FORMULARY & DRUG TIERS

Many Medicare Prescription Drug Plans group covered medications into tiers. The number of tiers may very from plan to plan. Generally, the lower the tier, the lower the cost of the drugs in the tier. It's true that the plan cost sharing amounts is the same for all drugs on a specific tier, however if the price at the pharmacy is lower, the member will not pay the plan copay. Some plans may apply a deductible to a specific tier(s). Here is an example:

Member Pays	What is Covered?
Lowest Copayment	Lower cost, commonly used generic drugs.
Lowest Copayment	Many generic drugs
Copyament (MA-PD)	name drugs
Coinsurance (PDP)	
Coinusrance	Unique and/or very high cost drugs

^{*} A preferredd brand-name prescription medication is a drug that has been determined by the Plan to be as effective as other medications.
